1. Laminated images included in the **Teacher Handbook** (or other photos) or use the locations listed below (glued on cardboard or made into an online interactive or smart board activity), jumble them up and have students (in groups or as a class) order the events in the correct sequence (dates provided in brackets are for teacher reference)

Events that can be included for the students to sequence:

WORLD WAR 1 STARTED (4 August 1914)

BLACKBOY HILL CAMP BEGAN (17 August 1914)

HMAT *MEDIC* and HMAT *ASCANIUS* LEFT FREMANTLE (October 31, joined Albany convoy 2 Nov)

11TH BATTALION ARRIVED IN EGYPT FOR TRAINING (December 1914)

GALLIPOLI LANDING (25 April 1915)

ANZAC TROOPS LEAVE GALLIPOLI (December 1915)

AIF JOIN BRITISH TROOPS ON THE WESTERN FRONT (1916)

ARMISTICE DAY (END OF WORLD WAR I) (November 1918)

2. Students can then create their own illustrated sequence of the major events, earliest to latest, in World War I.
